In 1996, Harmony Adoptions began offering specialized adoption services in East Tennessee, and we soon expanded our programs to serve the entire state. Harmony is recognized nationally for our adoption preparation and post-adoption services.

- Each year our programs serve over 1,000 of Tennessee's most vulnerable children and youth.
- Less than 1% of the adopted children we work with come back into foster-care, compared to a national rate of 15-20%. This saves the State of Tennessee \$6.5 million each year and, most importantly, keeps a child in the safety of his or her family.
- Our Adoption Support and Preservation program is nationally recognized and is the most comprehensive post-adoption service in the country.
- Each year we train over 2,000 professionals in our highly effective, evidence-based clinical protocols.
- Last year we found families for over 100 of the most difficult to place children, those living in foster care the longest with the most serious mental and physical disabilities.
- Harmony is certified through the prestigious Council on Accreditation, has 15 years of experience managing multi-million dollar contracts, and has the infrastructure to create and implement creative, effective programs.
- Founded fifteen years ago, Harmony's budget has grown to \$5,200,000 and now supports over 100 professional staff across Tennessee.
